

PLYWOOD

Material of the Modern World at the Victoria and Albert Museum until 12th November 2017.

I went today and can recommend this exhibition to anyone interested in plywood, who happens to be visiting London and definitely worth a trip if you live nearby.



This photo taken in available light shows bottom left the display on peeling veneer, in the centre a canoe made of veneer (only the stem and stern are glued separately) and to the right is a model of the De Havilland Mosquito. There was also a piece of actual fuselage, as well as a fine display of other examples including furniture, a part assembled Mirror dinghy, a surfboard, building frames and many other examples of plywood structures.
